- ✓ Marking obstacles
- ✓ Trimming trees

Safety During Winter Operations

Crew Safety

- ✓ Adequate sleep/rest
- ✓ Personal protective equipment
- ✓ Multi-layered warm clothing
 - Hardhat with liner
 - Safety vest
 - Safety shoes
 - o Boots
 - o Gloves
- ✓ Emergency survival kit
 - o First-aid kit
 - o Flashlight with extra batteries
 - Ice scraper/snow brush
 - o Jumper cables
 - Basic too kit
 - o Flares or reflectors
 - o Flags (traffic control)
 - Shovel and traction material (sand)
 - Fire extinguisher check pressure
 - Thermos and lunchbox (high protein snacks)

Material safety

- ✓ Material safety data sheets (MSDS)
- ✓ Emergency procedures

Vehicle and equipment safety

- ✓ Preventive maintenance
 - o Daily checks
- ✓ Pre-trip inspection
 - o Fluid levels
 - Tire tread and inflation
 - o Brakes
 - o Heater
 - Defroster
 - Windshield wipers
 - o Clean windows and mirrors
 - o Lights
 - o Backup alarm
 - Warning signs on rear of truck
 - o Radio Communications
 - o Full fuel tank

Facility safety

- ✓ Good housekeeping
- ✓ Well lit facility

Operations safety

- ✓ Safety belt
- ✓ Defensive driving
- ✓ Obey traffic laws
- ✓ Do not speed
- ✓ Safe backing circle-of-safety
- ✓ Allow sufficient stopping distance
- ✓ Dumb be no higher than cab top when moving
- ✓ Block plow before changing blade
- Disconnect spreader before unclogging
- ✓ Be aware of fatigue
