

# MOTOR-GRADER OPERATOR TRAINING



## Classroom Training

Focus on safety for employees and the traveling public.  
Equipment maintenance and gravel road issues.



## Field Training

The NDLTAP instructor will demonstrate to the operator the most efficient and effective techniques. The time spent in the field is one-on-one training.



## Cost

\$500 or \$125 per operator – minimum 4 operators
