The training covers boom mowers, flex-wing mowers, side-mounted mowers, and nearly any other tractor mowing setup.

Tractor Mower Operator Safety classroom course covers topics on:

- Becoming a responsible operator
- Managing hazards and risk
- Following a Safety Program
- Pre-Operation safety/walk around pre-start up inspections
- Best operating practices
- Proper start up and shut down procedures
- Hydraulic fluids safety
- Emphasizing Maintenance Safety



Hands-on field portion will take the operators out to the mowers they operate. Participants will do a walk around inspection of the equipment. The classroom material will be reinforced, and a driver's course will be set up that will allow each operator to demonstrate safety and proficiency with the equipment.
